

2013 PCIP/MRMIP Application and Handbook *Summary Updates*

Each year the PCIP/MRMIP Application and Handbook is revised to include the latest program information, new MRMIP monthly premium rates and plan information. The English version of the 2013 PCIP/MRMIP Application and Handbook is now available. The Spanish version of the 2013 PCIP/MRMIP Application and Handbook will be available soon.

Below is a list of summary updates for the 2013 PCIP/MRMIP Application and Handbook:

Page 2

- Added an Important Message regarding the PCIP program ending on December 31, 2013; and the California Health Benefit Exchange program that will be available for PCIP subscribers starting on January 1, 2014.

Page 4

- Added the new online fillable PDF PCIP application information that is now available for applicants to fill out and print a PDF version of the application to fax to PCIP.
- Added information regarding the new online payment methods in credit/debit card and e-check.

Page 5

- Added the clarification that the PCIP Program has a \$3000 out-of-network annual medical deductible to the PCIP and MRMIP comparison table.

Page 7

- Added the types of legal documentation that can be used as proof of an applicant's name change when enrolling in PCIP.

Page 9

- Added a new declaration to inform applicants that their application and enrollment information may be shared with the California Health Benefit Exchange (HBEX) as shown here:

“I understand that my application and enrollment information may be shared with the California Health Benefit Exchange (HBEX) for the purposes of facilitating enrollment in health coverage through the HBEX.”

Pages 10-15

- Updated the MRMIP Monthly Premium Rates for 2013. The MRMIP monthly premium rates were decreased for the 2013 calendar year due to the passage of Assembly Bill 1526 (Monning), which allows the MRMIB to set premiums for MRMIP subscribers at 100 percent of the standard premiums paid for comparable coverage in the private market during the calendar year of 2013.

Page 16

- Updated Kaiser Permanente's Toll-Free Number - Hours of Operations to 24 hours a day (except Holidays)

Page 22

- Added a new FAQ in regards to an applicant's legal name for enrollment into PCIP. PCIP can enroll an applicant with a name other than the name on his/her citizenship/immigration documents only if one of the legal documents as proof of the name on the application.

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- Added a new FAQ on how subscribers can pay their monthly premium for PCIP using the new payment methods online.

Page 25

- Updated the MRMIB Division information to Eligibility where an appeal must be filed in writing.
