Advisory Panel

MRMIB staff advertised the four vacancies on the HFP Advisory Panel on April 22, 2010 and solicited interested individuals. Last month, the Board reappointed the County Public Health Provider representative. The Board also received late notice of an incumbent panel member's interested in continuing their public service and received no other public interest in that vacancy. Staff will repost and re-advertising the remaining two vacancies plus an additional recent subscriber resignation. We will return with those panel recommendations in the near future.

Listed below is the staff recommendation for that one vacancy.

Family Practice Physician

Staff recommends the reappointment of Dr. Ellen Beck. Dr. Beck is the Director of the Community Education Division of Family Practice at UC, San Diego. She is a Board Certified Family Practice Physician. Dr. Beck also directs UCSD Student Run Free Clinic Project which also sees a large proportion of the area's Medi-Cal and Healthy Families insured residents. As the Director, she oversees a national faculty development and fellowship program that addresses the health needs of underserved populations. She is an active participant on the HFP Advisory Panel since December 2002.
