SUBJECT: Recommended Appointment to the Healthy Families Program (HFP)
Advisory Panel

MRMIB staff advertised the three vacancies on the HFP Advisory Panel on June 7, 2013, and solicited interested individuals. The Board received two applications for two of the three available vacancies. The Board also received notice of an incumbent panel member's interest in continuing their public service. Staff did not receive any interested parties for the representative for the Disproportionate Share Hospitals. We will continue outreach efforts to fill this vacancy and return with additional staff recommendations at a future Board meeting. Listed below are the staff recommendations for two of the three vacancies and for the reappointment.

Family Practice Physician

Staff recommends the reappointment of Ellen Beck, M.D. Dr. Beck is a Clinical Professor in the Department of Family and Preventative Medicine at University of California San Diego. She is a Board Certified Family Practice Physician. Dr. Beck also directs UCSD Student Run Free Clinic Project which also sees a large proportion of the area's Medi-Cal and Healthy Families insured residents. As the Director, she oversees a national faculty development and fellowship program that addresses the health needs of underserved populations. She is an active participant on the HFP Advisory Panel since December 2002.

County Public Health Provider

Staff recommends the appointment of Jared Ira Fine, D.D.S. Dr. Fine is the Dental Health Administrator of the Alameda County Public Health Department Division. He has directed numerous projects in the Bay Area to expand dental access, educate his community on dental care, and provide dental services to those in need. One such program is the Healthy Smiles Dental Treatment Program for Uninsured Children, where he has treated over 5,000 children since 2001.

Subscriber with a Special Needs Child

Staff recommends the appointment of Alice Mayall, Ph.D. Dr. Mayall has three children that have been in the HFP. Her two youngest children were transitioned to Medi-Cal on April 1, 2013. One of these children received Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services for his Autism Spectrum Disorder. Dr. Mayall is a Clinical Psychologist in Livermore, California, and received her Doctorate from Northern Illinois University.
