SUBJECT: Healthy Families Program Advisory Panel

The Managed Risk Medical Insurance Board (MRMIB/Board) is seeking applications for individuals to fill a vacancy on the Healthy Families Program (HFP) Advisory Panel. The Advisory Panel was established to advise the Board on policies, regulations, operation, and implementation of the HFP. The HFP is a state and federally subsidized children's health, dental, and vision insurance program for children in low to moderate income families. The program was implemented on July 1, 1998, and, at its peak, insured more than 850,000 children. Due to a change in state law, HFP subscribers have been transitioning to the Medi-Cal Program. This phased transition began on January 1, 2013, with an expected transition completion in November 2013. The Advisory Panel shall be moved under the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) as of 2014.

The Advisory Panel is comprised of 15 members who serve three-year staggered terms on a voluntary basis. Members are compensated for necessary travel expenses and those Advisory Panel members representing subscribers are provided with compensation of \$100.00 per meeting. The Advisory Panel meets quarterly with meetings typically scheduled from 10:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. in downtown Sacramento. The next meeting date is still to be determined in November and will occur in downtown Sacramento. MRMIB is seeking representatives from the following category:

1. Disproportionate Share Hospital
